

Conversation starters for Evangelism



Personal Evangelism is one of the greatest joys of following Christ. It is also very intimidating for many people, perhaps for you as well.

But the best way to grow in your skills is to learn how to talk about your faith in a conversational way. As you spend time with Jesus Christ on a regular basis and experience His blessings in your life, you will discover a growing desire to share your faith. In other words, the key to personal evangelism is to do it.

The goal is to have conversations with your friends, neighbors, and even those random strangers. Spiritual thirst is the key point to listen for. Spiritual thirst opens the doors to conversation which is natural and not fearful in any way.

Some questions are:

Do you believe in God?

Is there life after death?

What do you think is the correct ticket for entry into Heaven?

Who is Jesus Christ or what does Jesus Christ mean to you?

Why does Jesus Christ say: I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life?

Do you as an unbeliever know how you can find out that God exists?

When someone says: Yes, I want to know about it, then allow yourself to be led concerning a healing prayer or sinners prayer for the person. Ask the Lord to simply make himself known to the person, so that his or her heart will be opened and that he or she may be touched and/or healed.

More example questions:

Do you think much about spiritual things?

What is your concept of God? Do you view Him positively or negatively?

Have you ever come to a point in your life where you trusted Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and Lord, or do you think that is something you're still moving toward? May I share with you how I came to that point?

Do you find that faith and spiritual values play a role in your (work) (day) (marriage) (perspective on life)?

If you could be sure there is a God, would you want to know Him? Or if you could know God personally, would you want to?

Can I share the thing I've found most important to me as a (dad), (mom), (boss)?

Not many people say that they believe in God anymore. But what does believing in God mean to you?

Has someone ever taken the blame for something in which you deserved the punishment?

Do you believe that the devil exists?

Are you afraid of death?

Did you know that you have a soul?

Where do you think your soul is going?

Do you believe in Heaven and hell?

Are you aware of the fact that life can end at any moment?

Is there anything that you regret that you can't restore?

Are you religious? or do you have faith?

Do you believe Jesus Christ is alive?

How would you define sin?

Do you believe Jesus Christ is coming back again?

Do you know what the Rapture is?

Do you pray to God, and do you think there probably is a God who hears you?

Would you want to have a conversation with Jesus Christ?

Do you know how one becomes a Christian?

What is most important to you in your life?

Do you believe in Heaven? If so, do you know how to get there?

Some people say that by doing good deeds you can get into Heaven. Do you believe that?

Do you know that you can enter Heaven through Jesus Christ?

What is the reason that Jesus Christ died on the cross?

What is salvation?

Is baptism enough to get me right with God?

Is going to church enough for me to say that I am saved?
